

**Georgetown Peabody Library
Harry Potter Scavenger Hunt!
July 11th – July 15th
For students in grade 6 and up!**

Remember this is a scavenger hunt so you need to collect all of these items. Be creative. In the first part of the hunt some items you may not be able to find locally so draw or find pictures of the items requested. In the second part of the hunt, when looking for a book the note may not be in the book but rather taped to the area underneath or above where the book should be! Make sure you have a camera handy to take pictures of the items as you find them throughout the library!

1. Obtain a photograph or printout of the image of the first book in the series as it was written in England!
2. Find a basilisk in Georgetown! There may not be many real ones about but see what you can conjure up!
3. Gather half a galleon worth of pennies .
Hint: There are more than 10 sickles to a galleon!
4. Bring a feather the color of Harry's owl! It does not have to be an owl or a real feather!
5. Bring in a book or movie from the series.
6. Bring in a flower that resembles Mrs. Potter's Sister.
Hint: It is the name of Dudley's mother!
7. Find the website/address for the exciting new Potter event by J. K. Rowling. Bring in web address on piece of paper as well as a date or month mentioned there.
8. There is going to be a “Wizard School Scavenger Hunt” for Harry Potter fans in Boston soon. Find out what day and time and write it down on a piece of paper for us! Hint: Try searching the terms scavenger Hunt. It may be being held at a museum but not in Cambridge.
9. There is a series of books that are a spin off from the Harry Potter series and have to do with the creator of the sorcerer's/philosopher's stone. What are the names of the books and the author of them? Bring in the ISBN number of the first book in the series as well!
10. Find or create something that represents Gryffindor house at Hogwarts! Try to include house colors.
11. Find or create something that represents Hufflepuff house at Hogwarts! Try to include house colors.
12. Find or create something that represents Slytherin house at Hogwarts! Try to include house colors.
13. Find or create something that represents Ravenclaw house at Hogwarts! Try to include house colors.
